Getting ready

Step 0: Get a library card and a PIN

- See library staff if you need a PIN for your library card.







Step 1: Install the OverDrive app

- Go to the app store on your device. If can't find your app store, visit app.overdrive.com.
- Search for **OverDrive** and install the OverDrive app.

Step 2: Sign up for an OverDrive account (when prompted)

- You will be prompted to enter your email, a name, and a password.
- This will sync your downloaded OverDrive materials if you have multiple devices.
- If you are under 13, select "I am under 13 years old."






Step 3: Set up the app

-  Tap the **OverDrive** icon in the top left corner.
-  Tap **Add a library**.
-  Search for your library.
-  Tap **Southwest Wisconsin Library System - Platteville** (or your home library).
-  Tap the **star** next to "Wisconsin Public Library Consortium" to save it.
-  Tap **Wisconsin Public Library Consortium**.
- Tap **Sign In** in the top right corner.
 - *Your library's name*: type in "Platteville" (or your home library).
 - *Your library card number*: this is the 14-digit number on the back of your card (no spaces).
 - *PIN/Password*: see library staff if you need a PIN for your library card.

Hold:






- You may have up to ten items on hold at one time.
- You will receive an email when it is your turn to check out your hold.
- You have three days after the email has been sent to download your book.
- Holds must be placed through the OverDrive app or the *dbooks.wplc.info* website.
 - Holds for electronic books and audiobooks cannot be placed through the SWLS catalog.

Lending periods:







- eBooks may be checked out for 7, 14, or 21 days.
- Audiobooks may be checked out for 7 or 14 days.
- To set your default checkout period
 -  Tap your Account.
 -  Tap your Settings.
 -    Tap your preferred checkout period.

Using the app with Android devices

-  Tap the **OverDrive app** if you need to reopen the app. When you re-open the app:
 -  Tap the **OverDrive** icon in the top left corner.
 -  Tap the **Bookshelf** option.
 -  Tap **Add a Book: Wisconsin Public Library Consortium**.
 - Tap **Sign In** in the top right corner if you need to sign in.
-  Use the *search* option in the top right to search for books by author, title, or subject.
- Use the menu options across the top of the screen to browse for books by genre.
- Tap the *Show me... Available Now* option in any search to find books with no waiting list.



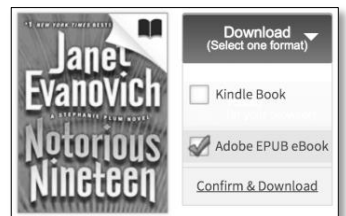
-  /   Tap **Borrow** to check out an available title.
-  /   Tap **Place a Hold** to be on the list for a checked out title.
- You may have up to ten items checked out at one time.




Downloading a book with an Android device

After you have opted to borrow a book, choose the format you want for your eBook.
Visit overdrive.com/drc if you don't know which formats work with your device.


• **Adobe EPUB books**

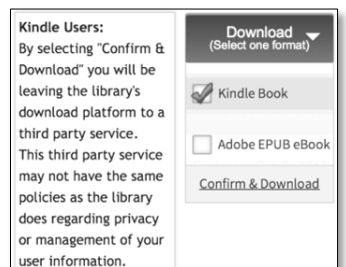
- Tap **Download**.
- Tap **Adobe EPUB eBook**.
- Tap **Confirm & Download**.
- Adobe EPUB books will show up on your OverDrive app bookshelf.
- To get back to your Adobe EPUB book:





-  Open the OverDrive app.
 -  If you don't see your eBook, tap the **OverDrive** icon in the top left corner.
 -  Tap the **Bookshelf** option to read the books you have downloaded.

• **Kindle books (requires a Kindle app and an Amazon account)**

- Tap **Download**.
- Tap **Kindle Book**.
- Tap **Confirm & Download**.
- You will be sent to your Amazon.com account.
-  From Amazon.com, tap **Get library book**.
- OverDrive Kindle books will show up with your purchased Amazon books in your Kindle app.



• **Read (in your browser)**

- This will open the eBook in the browser of your device.
- To access the book later:
 - Bookmark the webpage for the eBook. This will also let you read the book offline.
 - OR return your OverDrive account via your app OR by visiting **dbooks.wplc.info**.
 - Go to your **Account**  and then go to your **Bookshelf**  to reopen your book.
