Book recommendations

Check out a book from the Library(!), borrow one from a friend, visit a Little Free Library.

A book with a “Z”

Title starts with Z, author's name starts with Z, character's name starts with Z, features a zoo, set in Zimbabwe, dedicated to someone with a Z name

Italian connection

Set in Italy, based on Roman mythology, by an Italian-American author, cover painting by an Italian artist, has a scene at an Italian restaurant.

2026 goals

Set somewhere you'd like to travel, features something you want to learn, includes an experience you want to have this year.
